


Introduction

This Harley Benton 'Digital Delay' pedal has been specifically designed to provide a long delay of up to 5.2 s. The device is an extremely useful digital live and studio delay. It's easy to use with the 3 controls, and 7 delay modes provide a wide range of delays that contain the most widely used delay times and functions in modern music. The device offers two inputs so that it can also be used for stereo instruments, e. g. keyboards. Through the two outputs two amplifiers can be driven to provide also mono instruments with a spatial sound.

This pedal is equipped with heavy duty footswitch and die-cast housing, and its high quality effects provide your musical instruments with state-of-the-art delay sound.

You can power this device by an external DC 9 V power adapter or a 9 V alkaline battery. If you don't use this pedal for a longer period of time take out the battery to avoid leakage. Disconnect the input cable from the pedal when you don't use the device. This disconnects the battery from the circuitry and thus saves its capacity.



This device is intended to be used to generate an echo effect for instrument signals. Any other use or use under other operating conditions is considered to be improper and may result in personal injury or property damage. No liability will be assumed for damages resulting from improper use.
